**Some of the RESPONSIBILITIES of the MARHABA consultant are:**

- Help link Muslim community members to community based organizations and other resources.
- Conduct outreach activities to recruit Muslim women for a breast and cervical cancer screening program and research study.
- Lead education classes on breast and cervical cancer with group of Muslim women at mosques or other community sites.
- Help Muslim women make appointments to get screened for breast and cervical cancer.
- Give Muslim women individual education, counseling and support as needed.
- Keep organized logs and notes.
- Conduct surveys with Muslim women to understand the impact of the program.
- Keep participants motivated and engaged in the program and study by conducting regular follow-up through phone and in-person.
- Participate in learning exchanges and trainings.
- Assist with development and translation of hand-outs, flyers, and other materials on breast and cervical cancer for Muslim women.
- Report to project supervisors via email or phone every other week.
- Participate in meeting with other MARHABA consultants every other month by conference call or in-person meetings.

**We are looking for MARHABA consultants who have the following QUALIFICATIONS:**

- Prior involvement in and familiarity with NYC Muslim community-based organizations, community leaders, and community resources.
- Bi-lingual in English and one of the following languages: in Bengali, French, Arabic, Urdu, or Indonesian
- Basic computer knowledge/skills required.
- Strong organizational skills.
- Available to work evenings and weekends.
- Available to travel throughout Manhattan, Queens, Brooklyn, and the Bronx.
- Warm, friendly, open, energetic.
- Works well with a wide range of people.
- Fast learner.
- Creative personality.
- Strong communication skills.

**Some of the REQUIREMENTS of becoming a MARHABA consultant are:**

- Complete all NYU Medical Center forms and interviews to become consultant.
- Attend at least 9 hours of Lay Health Worker trainings.
- Pass all competency exams related to trainings.
- Talk to about 20 Muslim women per month about the project and enroll about 10 Muslim women per month into the project.

**Becoming a MARHABA consultant has the following benefits:**

- Financial compensation based on outreach and enrollment totals
- Access to educational trainings to build your skills
- Helping Muslim women in your community
- Certificate of recognition from the program
