



New Research Study At NYU Langone School of Medicine for Providers that treat Adult Males in Flatbush Family Health Center (LFHC)

The purpose of this study is to test the effectiveness of Community Health Worker decision coaching program on prostate cancer screening decision quality for Black men.

This study will enroll patients at your clinic over the next 4 years. Enrolled patients will receive decision coaching directly prior to their primary care clinical appointment with you. The visits will be at Flatbush Family Health Center.

Your commitment as a participant in this study will include:

- 2 one-time surveys: one before the study starts and once after we reach target enrollment of patient subjects.
- post-encounter survey following the clinical appointment of each enrolled patient subject that you treat during the study period
- the Decision Coach will accompany enrolled patients to the clinical appointment and audio record your encounter with your patients.
- an in-depth interview (approximately one hour) following study completion. The interview will be audio recorded.

There is no cost to you or your patients for participation in the study.

If you agree to participate in this research, you will receive \$75 per individual patient participant seen during clinical appointments and completion of accompanying assessments. The incentives are intended to compensate for the supplemental time that providers devote to each intervention participant appointment that is lost from regular clinical time

Your decision to participate in this study will not affect your reputation, employment status, professional evaluation, and relationships. Records of participation in research can't be linked to an employment record. Your responses will be de-identified and kept confidential among the study team. Your employer will not be made aware of your enrollment status and responses to surveys and interviews will not be shared with your employer.
