# STAMP OUT CANCER BROOKLYN



Stamp Out Cancer Brooklyn (SOCB) is a community-based initiative that focuses on cancer prevention and reducing cancer care gaps in Brooklyn. SOCB is led by Perlmutter Cancer Center, as part of its Community Outreach and Engagement Core, and in partnership with the Family Health Centers at NYU Langone and the Department of Population Health. The project engages trusted community stakeholders with the goal of developing evidence-based solutions for cancer prevention, early detection, treatment, and survivorship.

Our cancer prevention efforts focus on healthy eating, tobacco cessation, and vaccination against and treatment for infection-related cancers. Early cancer detection, timely care, continuity of care, mental health, and social support are critical to improving health outcomes and mental wellbeing among people with cancer and survivors. Moreover, our work supports policies to prevent cancer and mitigate adverse and disproportionate cancer-related health outcomes.



**We focus on improving health equity and access by providing patients with essential links to:**

- Healthy eating
- Active living
- Tobacco cessation
- Cancer prevention and treatment services
- Support
- Vaccines and treatment for infection-related cancers (hepatitis A, B, and C; the human papillomavirus (HPV); and *Helicobacter pylori* [*H. pylori*])

**Our patient navigators help people access culturally competent healthcare and other resources by:**

- providing community outreach and education to demystify and destigmatize cancer prevention.
- assisting with navigation to cancer screening and follow-up care.
- connecting patients with community-based organizations that address environmental concerns related to cancer prevention and care.
- communicating with patients in their own language, including Arabic, Chinese, Russian, and Spanish.
