



The New York University – City University of New York School of Public Health Prevention Research Center (NYU-CUNY PRC) is an innovative partnership between the NYU School of Medicine and the CUNY School of Public Health (SPH) to translate and adapt evidence-based interventions into integrated community-clinical approaches to reduce cardiovascular disease disparities in New York City.

The Muslim Americans Reaching for Health and Building Alliances (MARHABA) project will evaluate the effectiveness of a culturally adapted Lay Health Workers (LHW) intervention designed for Muslim women to increase breast and cervical cancer screening participation. The project will compare the use of culturally targeted small media delivered by a LHW (SM-LHW) to small coupled with LHW-led Patient Navigation (PN-LHW arm) for cancer screening among Muslim women over 40 years in New York City. The project will collaborate with a number of community-based organizations across Manhattan, Queens, Brooklyn and the Bronx, including mosques, social service agencies and provider groups. The position will be based at NYU School of Medicine.

Responsibilities

- Liaison between Muslim community members and community based organizations.
- Conduct outreach activities to recruit potential participants for the study.
- Conduct culturally appropriate health education workshops on breast and cervical cancer with Muslim participants.
- Assist participants in making appointments to get screened for breast and cervical cancer .
- Keep organized study logs and data files.
- Provide individual education, counseling and support
- Conduct baseline and follow-up interviews with participants.
- Keep participants motivated and engaged in the study.
- Participate in learning exchanges and trainings.
- Assist with development and translation of culturally specific hand-outs, flyers and other materials on breast and cervical cancer.
- Report to project supervisors.

Qualifications

- Minimum of high school education/GED required. Bachelors degree preferred but not required.
- Minimum 1 year of experience in community-based clinical or social service delivery.
- Prior involvement in and familiarity with NYC Muslim community-based organizations, community leaders, and community resources.
- Bi-lingual in English and one of the following languages: in Bengali, French, or Arabic

The Chinese American Research and Education (CARE) project examines the feasibility, acceptability, and potential efficacy of a social-media based intervention on glycemic control in Chinese Americans with type 2 diabetes. CARE is a 6-month pilot randomized controlled trial, with participants randomized to a wait-list control or the intervention. Intervention participants receive culturally and linguistically tailored diabetes self-management videos for 12 weeks, as well as biweekly phone calls from a community health worker








Clicking the 'Request Access' button will open an email addressed to the CHW Research & Resource Center, which can be used to email a request for the specific Resource.

Community Health Workers (also known as Promotores de Salud, Community Health Representatives, Community Health Advisors) are frontline public health workers who are trusted members of and/or have an unusually close understanding of the community served.

The idea for the Community Health Worker Resource Hub grew from a desire to compile and share the vast body of work developed for CHW interventions and initiatives across NYU Langone, often in close collaboration with community partners. We hope the wealth of knowledge and expertise that guided the creation of these resources will be of benefit to researchers, community members, and CHWs who are looking to develop, enhance, or evaluate a CHW project. The Hub's search categories and filters are intended to capture what site users may find most interesting and helpful. If you have any suggestions for improvement, or if you find a document that is not correctly tagged, please let us know.

The CHW Resource Hub is an initiative of the NYU Community Health Worker Research & Resource Center (CHW-RRC).

About the Center

The Community Health Worker Research & Resource Center (CHW-RRC) is housed in the Department of Population Health at NYU Grossman School of Medicine and supported by NYU Langone's Community Service Plan. The CHW-RRC is led by a CHW Committee made up of a rotating group of 4-6 CHWs and patient navigators across NYU Langone (Brooklyn and Manhattan). We also convene a stakeholder group that helps guide CHW-RRC activities which includes faculty, CHW supervisors, program staff, as well as representatives from the CHW Committee.

The CHW-RRC aims to serve as a hub for NYU Langone's extensive CHW-related knowledge and expertise in order to strengthen and support emerging and existing programs, both within and beyond NYU Langone, to improve health, reduce health inequities, and recognize and help build community capacity and leadership. Our Team does this by cultivating a culturally competent CHW workforce, providing training, support, and professional development opportunities to this workforce, supporting community-clinical linkage models, and stimulating cross-project learning of best practices in community and patient engagement.


